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Holiday Travelers Will Find New Eateries at Washington Airports This Season

Travelers going through Washington Dulles International and Ronald Reagan Washington National Airports this holiday season are in for a culinary treat, especially those who have not visited the Airports recently. Over the past year, the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority has accelerated its efforts to bring passengers a broad variety of recognizable national and local concepts with reasonable pricing.

Passengers at Reagan National can now add a Cosi Restaurant in National Hall to their presecurity dining options. Post-security, Terminal A has a re-styled EuroCafe and in Terminal B/C the South Pier boasts Tidewater Landing, a new full-service restaurant. On the Center Pier, Fuddruckers and Mayorga Coffee join the eating alternatives.
