## Dulles Airport Exit Lane to Route 28 North (Sterling) Will Close Overnight Thursday, April 19 for Construction

The exit lane from Washington Dulles International Airport to northbound Route 28 (towards Sterling) will be closed for construction from

10 p.m. on Thursday, April 19 until  
5 a.m. on Friday, April 20.

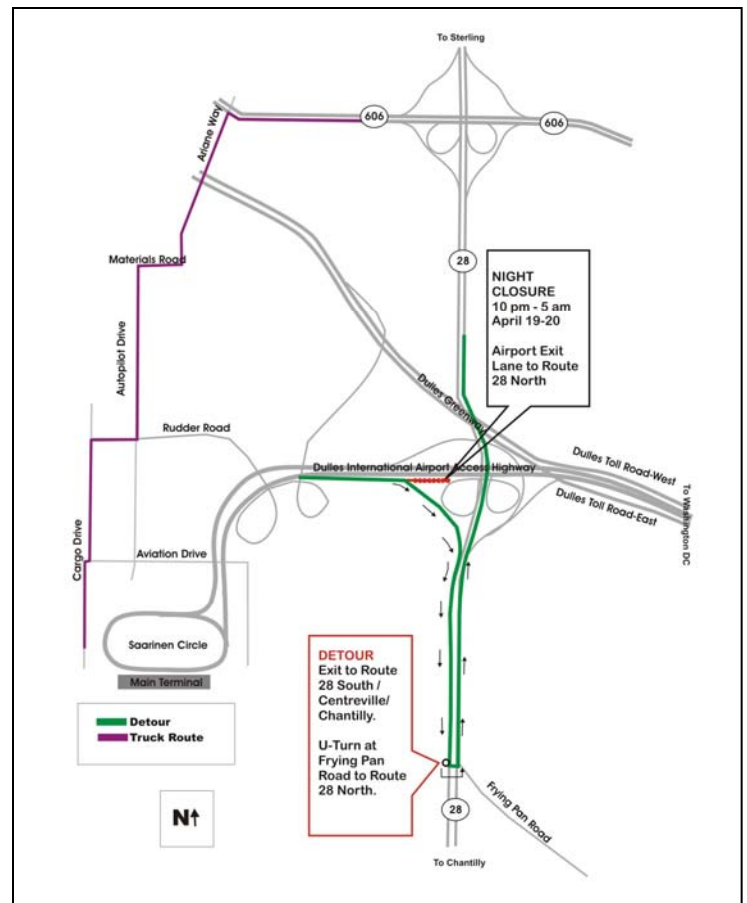
Drivers leaving the Airport who need to go north on Route 28 should follow traffic signs to take the following detour:

- Exit the Airport onto Route 28 South (toward Centreville)
- At the first traffic light (Frying Pan Road), make a U-turn onto Route 28 North

This overnight closure will not affect drivers traveling to the Airport or those leaving the Airport to travel towards Washington, D.C. on the Dulles Airport Access Highway.

The overnight ramp closure is necessary for construction work on a new overpass which will make it easier for traffic leaving the Airport to merge onto the eastbound Dulles Airport Access Highway.

This \$56 million roadway improvement project concentrates on the north area of Dulles where vehicles enter and exit the Airport. The project is part of the D2, Dulles Development program, and is expected to be completed in Spring 2008.
