DRIVERS URGED TO CHECK AHEAD OF TIME BEFORE PARKING AT REAGAN NATIONAL AIRPORT

Parking Lots Expected to Fill to Capacity in Midweek Now Through Summer

The Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority is advising motorists who are planning to drive and park at Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport to check parking availability before traveling to the airport. Parking is expected to be at a premium Tuesdays through Thursdays from now through the summer.

Or motorists can call 703-417-PARK (703-417-7275) for current parking information provided by a parking aid 24-hours-a-day.

Passengers should plan ahead to avoid delays when parking reaches capacity. Travelers are encouraged to make alternate transportation arrangements, including taxis or Metro—which provides direct service to Reagan National.

Daily parking garages tend to fill during the middle of the week while economy lots tend to fill on weekends. When demand is especially heavy, all lots may fill

The Airports Authority has added more than 500 parking spaces at Reagan National Airport over the past two years by converting employee parking spaces for public use. More parking is planned when the Airports Authority begins construction of a 1,300-space addition on the existing garages later this year.
