## New Addition to Concourse B Opens at Dulles Airport

### *Passengers Alerted to New Shuttle Boarding Locations for All Airport Concourses*

The Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority announces the opening of a new 15-gate extension on the west end of Concourse B at Washington Dulles International Airport. The new gates are numbered B62 through B79. Three airlines—Air Tran, Jet Blue and Virgin America—are scheduled to begin operation in the new locations on Tuesday, January 15. American and Delta airlines are scheduled to begin operations in this new location later this year.

Passengers who have flights departing from Concourse B have a choice of routes from the Main Terminal and shuttle service is provided to all gates.

- **B14 through B51:** The most convenient route is the Walkway with Moving Sidewalks (follow signs to "Walkway to B").
- **B62 through B79:** Take the shuttle located immediately behind the security checkpoint.

Passengers should also note: **The Main Terminal boarding locations for shuttle service to Concourses C and D have changed.** After passing through security, follow the signs to the appropriate shuttle.

This expansion of Concourse B is part of the D2 Dulles Development program. Since 2001, the Airports Authority has invested more than \$3 billion in improvements at Dulles Airport. The completion of the \$137 million Concourse B extension is an important milestone in the D2 program as it completes the build-out of Concourse B, Dulles Airport's first permanent midfield concourse. The new addition adds 240,000 square feet bringing Concourse B to a total of 800,000 square feet and measuring 2,810 feet in length. The international flags hanging in the original section of Concourse B will be complemented by U.S. state flags in the extension, representing the domestic air service offered here.

Look for several new food concessions in the Concourse B extension, including: Auntie Anne's Pretzel Company, Bananas, Green Leaf's, Max & Erma's Restaurant along with Concourse Concessions News.
