Registered Traveler Lanes Open at Reagan National and Dulles International

The Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority announces the opening of Registered Traveler security lanes at both Ronald Reagan Washington National and Washington Dulles International Airports.

The Registered Traveler program is designed to enhance customer service and improve screening wait times. Passengers who choose to enroll for a fee in the Registered Traveler program will voluntarily submit biographic and biometric information for processing by the Transportation Security Administration (TSA). After being accepted into the program, passengers will be permitted to use the new designated Registered Traveler lanes where they will be aided by contract personnel who will help them divest and retrieve their belongings after being screened by TSA officers.

The Airports Authority contracted with Verified Identity Pass Inc. to implement the program at both of Washington's airports. Enrollees in the program will also have access to registered traveler security lanes at all other U.S. airports with similar programs.
