Airports Authority to Hold Regulatory Public Hearings on Proposal to Require Hotel Shuttle Service Providers at Reagan National and Dulles International Airports to Obtain a Permit to Operate at the Airports

The Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority will hold two public hearings on an Airports Authority Regulation that it is considering for adoption. The public hearings will be held on the following dates and locations

Monday, March 2, 2009 at 7 p.m.

(across from Baggage Claim #2 in the lower level of the Main Terminal)

The Airports Authority conducts a public hearing whenever it is considering the adoption or amendment of a regulation. The Airports Authority is now considering the adoption of a new Metropolitan Washington Airports Regulation Section 6.6, *Hotel Shuttles, Permit or Contract Required.*

The proposed regulation would require hotel shuttle service operators to and from Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport or Washington Dulles International Airport to obtain a permit from the Airports Authority, which would require the permit holder to:

- 1. Pay \$2.50 each time a hotel shuttle picks up passengers at one of the airports;
- 2. Carry the minimum insurance set by the President of the Airports Authority;
- 3. Comply with the requirements established by the Airport Manager for administering the program, including those to facilitate computation of trip fees; and
- 4. Comply with the provisions of the Metropolitan Washington Airports Regulation Section 4.5, which addresses the locations where hotel shuttles must pick up and discharge passengers.
