## Airports Authority to Hold Regulatory Public Hearing on Proposed Increase to the Dispatch Fee Charged to Taxicabs Operating at Reagan National Airport

The Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority will hold a public hearing on an Airports Authority Regulation that it is considering amending. The public hearing will be held on the following date and location:

**Monday, March 2, 2009 at 7:30 p.m.**

The Airports Authority conducts a public hearing whenever it is considering the adoption or amendment of a regulation. The Airports Authority is now considering amending Metropolitan Washington Airports Regulation Section 5.6, *Operating Conditions for the Taxicab Dispatch System*.

The proposed amendment would increase the dispatch fee charged taxicabs operating at Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport from \$1.75 to \$2.50.

Members of the public may speak about the adoption of this proposed amendment at the public hearing on March 2, 2009. Speakers must limit their remarks to five minutes.
