Night Repaving Work Planned for Dulles Airport Access Highway

Roadway milling and repaving operations will temporarily close one of the two travel lanes along a portion of the Dulles Airport Access Highway in the overnight hours beginning Monday, April 13. Drivers using the highway during the daytime will be able to use all regular travel lanes weekdays between 5:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. and all day on weekends. Adverse weather conditions could shift the planned roadwork schedule detailed below:

Westbound Dulles Airport Access Highway

- April 13 – April 15
- Between I-495 and Spring Hill Road
- Milling and repaving work from 9:00 p.m. through 5:00 a.m.
- One lane will remain open to traffic

Eastbound Dulles Airport Access Highway

- April 16 – April 24 (excluding weekends)
- Between Spring Hill Road and Route 123
- Milling and repaving work from 9:00 p.m. through 5:00 a.m.
- One lane will remain open to traffic

The work is necessary to improve the driving surface of the Dulles Airport Access Highway in this section near the Capital Beltway. The Dulles Toll Road will not be affected by this roadwork.
