Governor of Virginia Appoints Three Members to Airports Authority Board of Directors

Governor Timothy M. Kaine of the Commonwealth of Virginia has made appointments to the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority Board of Directors

Mame Reiley, who was appointed to the Board in 2002 by Governor Mark R. Warner, and has served as Chairman of the Board, has been reappointed to a second term on the Board. Ms. Reiley is the Immediate Past Chairman of the Airports Authority, and Chairman of the Board's Dulles Corridor Committee. She is President of The Reiley Group, a consulting, fundraising and events communication firm in Alexandria, Virginia.

She served as a senior advisor to Virginia Governor Tim Kaine and former Governor Mark Warner. Ms. Reiley was the Senior Political Advisor for Governor Warner and the Director of his OneVirginia PAC. Over the years, Ms. Reiley has served as Vice President of PGI/Washington, Inc., an events and communications agency, as Chief of Staff to Congressman James Moran (D-VA), and as a senior staff member of the House Committee on Appropriations.

She was elected to the Democratic National Committee from Virginia in 1992 and is currently the Chair of the Women's Caucus of the DNC. She also serves on the DNC's Executive Committee, as well as its Rules and Bylaws Committee, and is a member of the Economic Club of Washington and the Federal City Council Executive Committee.
